REBEKAH HAGAN, GUEST SPEAKER

This year's featured speaker, Rebekah Hagan, is one of the nation's youngest speakers on the issue of unplanned pregnancies and one of the first to undergo a successful abortion pill reversal. At age twenty, she began speaking across the United States and sharing her own story of hope and redemption, which has caught the attention of both local and national media, as well as religious and secular organizations. She also is an advocate for abortion pill reversal bills and has spoken in front of legislators in several states to advocate for new laws, including Nebraska.

A passionate advocate for grace-centered outreach, Rebekah Hagan uses her story to unravel the mindset of women in unplanned pregnancies and to equip and encourage others to lead with hope and compassion.

"Because one pregnancy center stood in the gap and answered my frantic call, I was able to receive help from the abortion pill reversal regimen. My 'yes' to choosing life and parenting was only possible because of their 'yes' to helping pregnant women in need."

Rebekah is a graduate of William Jessup University, and she and her family reside in California, where she works for Senator Jean Fuller as well as her local pregnancy center.
